SCREENPLAY ENTRY GUIDELINES:

REGULAR DEADLINE: August 15, 2016

1. Competition is open to screenplays that abide by the International Family Film Festival (IFFF) Vision Statement:

“IFFF builds a peaceful global family through the discovery and sharing of quality stories by independent artists and production companies.”

Any subject matter may be covered within these categories: animation, comedy, drama, musical and sci-fi/fantasy.

2. All screenplay entries must include:

1. Entry Form
2. Entry fee
3. 2 printed copies of the screenplay (Your name should NOT appear anywhere on the screenplay as it is mandatory that adjudication is conducted without knowledge of the writer's name or identity)
4. Character Description (for possible inclusion in the Screenwriters Showcase)
5. 50-words or less of Synopsis for the Program Book
6. Synopsis should also be bound within the screenplay
7. SASE if you want your screenplay returned.

Incomplete forms may cause delays.

OR If you enter your screenplay on www.filmfreeway.com, you may download the screenplay and the IFFF office will make the copies.

3. Screenplays that are currently optioned or sold are not eligible for competition.

4. Feature length screenplays must be no longer than 120 pages and short screenplays should be no more than 45 pages. All screenplay entries must be written in English. Any revisions after the entry has been entered are not accepted. Screenplays must be in 12pt courier font, no promotional materials or illustrations are accepted, pages must be numbered, and be on 3 hole punched paper with brads. No “shooting” or “directors” screenplays will be accepted.

5. It is the responsibility of the screenwriter to insure that their work is protected (US Copyright Office, The Writers Guild of America or Screenwriters Federation of America). International entries should protect their work with similar organizations within their respective country.

6. The IFFF Program Book deadline for Ads is October 12, 2016, and the Ad Spec sheet is available on the IFFF website at info@iffilmfest.org.

SCREENWRITERS SHOWCASE:

The IFFF Screenwriters Showcase will spotlight the Feature and Short screenplay Finalists from all categories with a "reading" of one scene from each screenplay by professional actors on Sunday, October 23, 2016. The actors are from the Lauren Patrice Nadler Studios.

All screenwriters select a scene from their screenplay and specify the page numbers pertaining to that scene in the *probability* that their screenplay is selected as a Finalist in a designated IFFF screenplay category for the Screenwriters Showcase.

SCREENPLAY JUDGING:

1. All screenplays are read by industry professionals. All decisions by the IFFF Juries are final.
2. By submitting this entry form and the fee, you agree to abide by the IFFF Jury decisions.
3. The Feature and Short Screenplay Finalists will be listed on the IFFF website by September 6, 2016 or soon after. Website: www.iffilmfest.org.
4. The announcement of the IFFF Feature and Short Screenplay Winners will be made at the IFFF Screenwriters Showcase and Awards Ceremony on Sunday, October 23, 2016.
